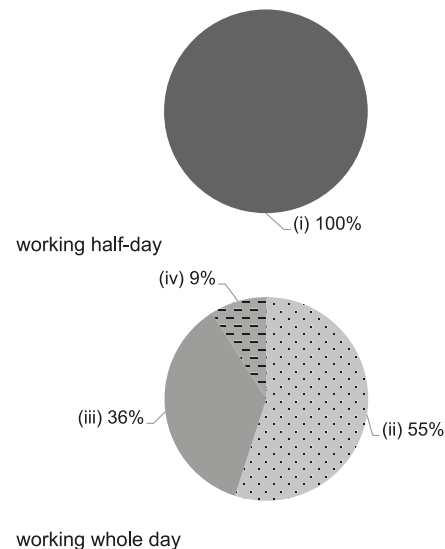

Various activities are provided to help them explore voluntarily and learn. Moral and civic educations are emphasized. Children are guided to foster good learning attitude and living habits, and attain balanced development in moral, communal, physical and artistic aspects.</p> <p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>Through thematic approach, specially designed activities, group learning and individual learning, children learn in action and exploration through sensory contact. Native-speaking teachers and specialists are employed to teach the English language and Putonghua. Other activities include the little bee boy scout and girl guide.</p>

<p>Children's developments in all aspects are observed and recorded in ongoing and conclusive manner. Children's learning progress is reviewed on regular basis.</p>

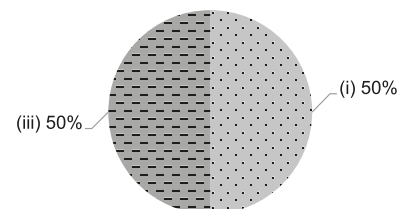
